### **PLANNING REPORT**

Planning is a growing problem in our area. In trying to control the spread of development, as you are aware, a Neighbourhood Plan is being prepared by a keen band of Parishioners to present to our Borough Masters WBC for adoption. When adopted it gives the Parish a strong set of teeth to agree or otherwise on developments within our boundary. An example of this is the disgraceful approval of more than 50 flats at the roundabout of the A4 by Pound Lane, as a Parish we would, hopefully, stop this happening with the plan in place. We as a Planning Committee look at all applications by visiting site, talking to neighbours and making a decision at our twice monthly public meetings, the decision is also posted on the WBC Website planning page. There are a number of sites highlighted by WBC for development which if we are not vigilant will be developed joining Sonning with Charvil, Woodley, Reading etc. If as Parishioners, you find building works that have not been approved please let us know and we will investigate.
